BBAO Rewards Trip

To mark a positive end to the school half term the reward trip for those students who have worked hard in lessons and have continued or improved on their good behaviour will be to Port Lympne Wildlife Park.

The trip will take place on **Friday 18th October 2019** and will run throughout the whole school day.

The school will look at the recent behaviour tracking to decide which students would be eligible to take part, so please remind students to take this into consideration as we draw nearer the event.

Students should arrive in school promptly at normal time wearing their own clothes and appropriate comfortable footwear.
